FINNISH OVEN PANCAKE (Marti Horwitz recipe)

- Preheat oven to 425 degrees.
- In a medium bowl stir together 1 tbsp. of sugar, ½ cup of flour, and 1 tsp of salt. Add 4 eggs and a cup of milk. Let sit for ½ to 1 hour at room temperature. Melt ¼ cup of butter in 9x13 baking pan in hot oven.
- Pour batter into the baking pan and bake for 15 minutes.
- Serve with whipped cream and berries syrup or squeeze lemon on the top and sprinkle powdered sugar.
